What It Is

Be part of a select group of sewists with a direct line into the Oliver + S and Liesl + Co. design studio and access to Liesl.

As part of our Advisors Circle, you'll contribute your ideas to our pattern development process, and you'll have the opportunity to sew special projects that will expand your horizons and deepen your skills. You'll also get an insider's perspective on our business.

Occasionally Liesl will reach out to Advisors Circle members with her ideas for special, custom sewing projects that make use of our patterns. If you sign up to sew one of the project ideas, you'll get personal instruction and advice from Liesl to help you to make the special project and hopefully learn some new skills in the process. In exchange, you'll photograph your creation and contribute a post to the Oliver + S blog about your work (giving you credit, of course, and the opportunity to also share your work on your blog and/or social media channels).

As part of our Advisors Circle, we'll occasionally ask you for feedback and opinions about upcoming project and pattern ideas, and you'll get sneak peeks and insight on what's coming next, as well as the opportunity to help guide our decisions. You'll get early access to forthcoming patterns and individual attention from Liesl. This is a great opportunity to learn while contributing to the Oliver + S and Liesl + Co. community as an active member.

This isn't a request for pattern testers. This is a new idea and opportunity for people with a desire to expand their sewing knowledge and become an active part of the sewing community.

Requirements

- Good photography skills and writing skills. (You may have already honed these skills on your own blog.)
- Some sewing experience. Neatness and attention to detail counts. Expert level is not a requirement; just patience and a desire to continue developing your skills.
- An ability to follow directions as well as to solve problems creatively. A willingness to experiment is important!
- Enthusiasm for the sewing community. A desire to teach others and become involved.
- Experience sewing with Oliver + S and/or Liesl + Co. patterns.

Time Commitment

This will vary and will be up to the individual. We hope to have between six and eight people on the team. We'd like to have a blog post from someone in the group once every few weeks, so each person would average a project every three to six months or so (or more if you prefer to want to contribute more!). There will be lots of opportunity here for enthusiastic sewists, and we're open to ideas as well. It is very important, though, that we be able to count on you. If you agree to take on a project, we'll be relying on you to satisfy the commitment within the agreed-upon time frame.

What Participants Will Receive for Participation

- Free patterns and other sewing products.
- Early access to new patterns before they are released to the public.
- The opportunity to give us direct feedback and ideas; you get to help guide the direction we take for new pattern ideas and upcoming projects!
- Personal attention from Liesl on the projects you choose to undertake. If you choose a project from the
 ideas we send out, you'll discuss it with Liesl and will work with her individually to plan how to tackle the
 project.
- · Other opportunities as they arise.
